Chord progression for the first staff: D, D, Bm, A7

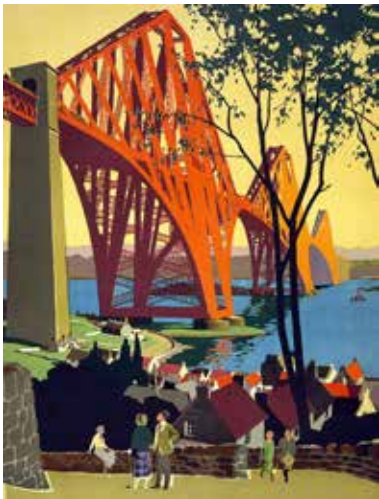
Chord progression for the second staff: Em, A7, D

Chord progression for the sixth staff: Em, D, A7, G, D, A7, D



The Forth Bridge was composed by Edinburgh fiddler and violin maker Williamson Blyth (1821-1897). It would have been written in the early 1890s, as the bridge opened in 1890.
