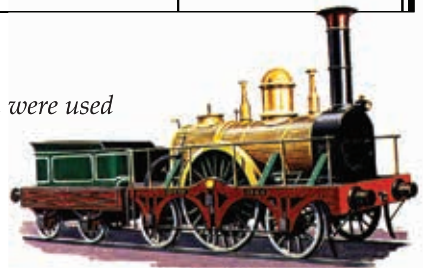

### 1837 A Scottish Passenger Railway
