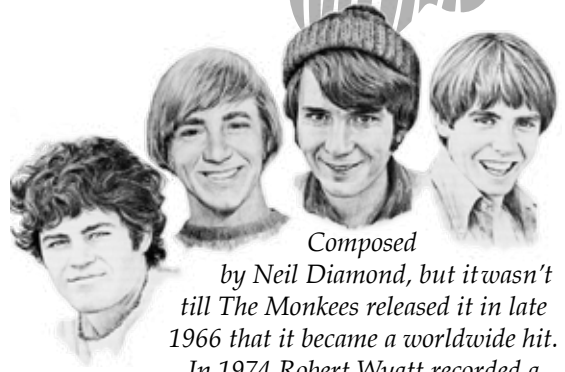
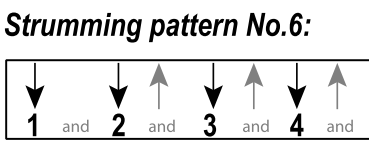
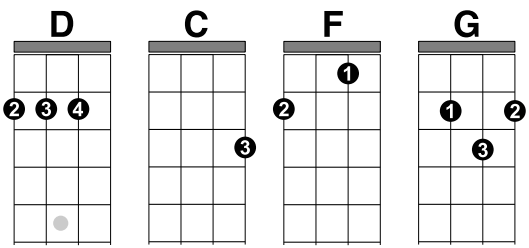
## I'm a Believer (Neil Diamond)
