Oh, babe, I hate to go....

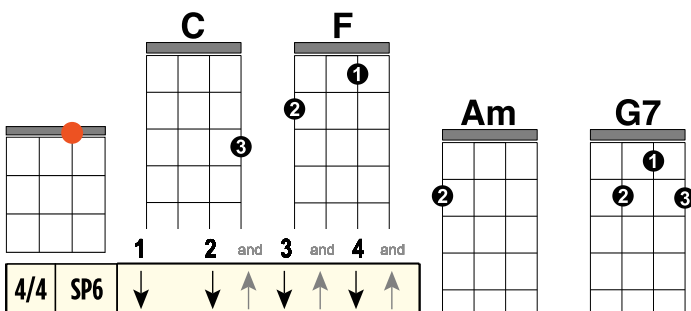
**2** There's so many times I've let you down, so many times I've played around,
