 The baffled king composing Hallelujah.

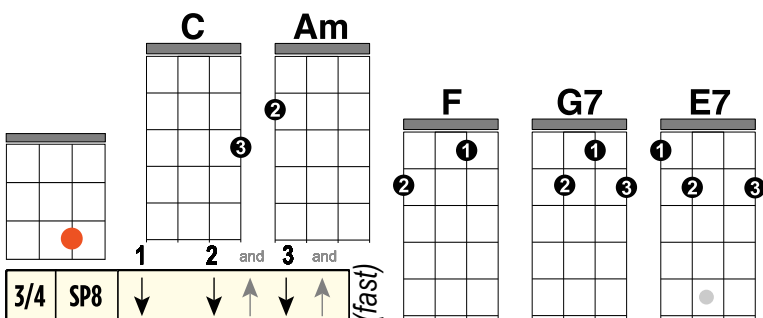
**Ch** Halle - lujah, halle - lujah, halle- lujah, halle- lu - u - jah.
