Gavotte (Sullivan)

This piece was composed by Arthur Sullivan (1842 – 1900) as a song within *The Gondoliers*, one of 14 operatic collaborations with the lyricist W S Gilbert. *The Gondoliers* premiered in December 1889, and ran continuously until mid-1891 (554 performances).
