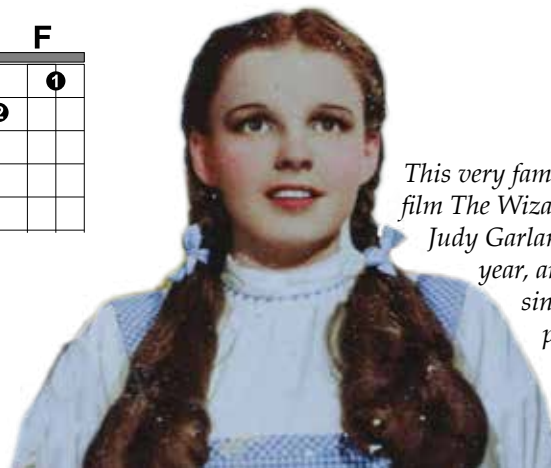
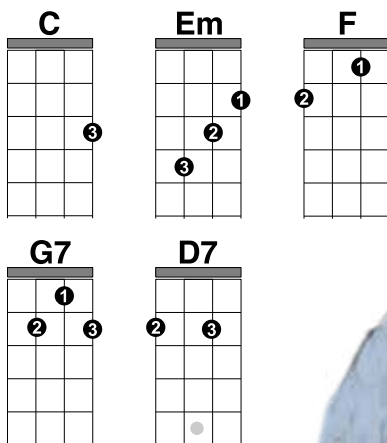
**1** C / Em / F / C /
