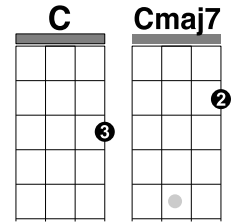

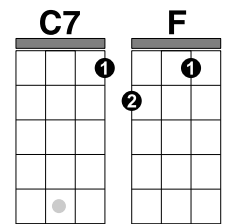


Raindrops Keep Falling On my Head (Bacharach/David)

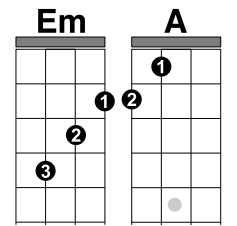
1 *C* *C^{maj7}*

 Raindrops are falling on my head, they keep falling, so I just



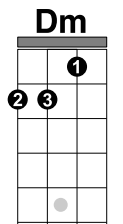
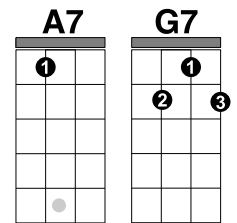
2 *C* *C^{maj7}*

 Won't defeat me, it won't be long till happiness steps up to greet me.



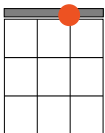
3 *C* *C^{maj7}*
