the strain, ain't it a shame?

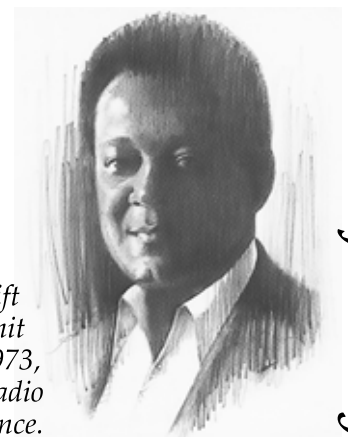
Ch Oh, give me the beat boys, and free my soul, I wanna get lost in your rock
