## Hey Jude (Lennon/McCartney)

**1** <sup>G D D7 G</sup>  
Hey Jude, don't make it bad, take a sad song and make it better.  
<sup>C G D7 G</sup>  
Remember to let her into your heart, then you can start to make it better.

**2** <sup>G D D7 G</sup>  
Hey Jude, don't be afraid - you were made to go out and get her;  
<sup>C G D7 G</sup>  
The minute you let her under your skin, then you begin to make it better.

**Br** <sup>G7 C Am D7</sup>  
And anytime you feel the pain, hey Jude, refrain, Don't carry the world  
<sup>G G7 C</sup>  
upon your shoulder; For well you know that it's a fool who plays it  
<sup>Am D7 G G7 D D7</sup>  
cool, By making his world a little colder, na na na na na, na na na na!

**3** <sup>G D D7 G</sup>  
Hey Jude, don't let me down, you have found her, now go and get her.  
<sup>C G D7 G</sup>  
Remember to let her into your heart, then you can start to make it better.

**Br** <sup>G7 C Am D7</sup>  
So let it out and let it in, hey Jude, begin, You're waiting for someone to  
<sup>G G7 C Am</sup>  
perform with; And don't you know that it's just you, hey Jude, you'll do,  
<sup>D7 G G7 D D7</sup>  
The movement you need is on your shoulder, na na na na na, na na na na!

**Repeat verse 1, then:**

..better, better, better, better, better, ah!

<sup>G F C G</sup>  
Na na na na na na na, Na na na na, hey Jude (x as many times as you like)
