1 ^A I once had a girl, or should I say, she once had me. ^G ^A
^A She showed me her room, isn't it good, Norwegian Wood. ^G ^A
^{Am} She asked me to stay and she told me to sit anywhere; ^D
^{Am} So I looked around and I noticed there wasn't a chair. ^{Bm7} ^{E7}

2 ^A I sat on a rug biding my time, drinking her wine. ^G ^A
^A We talked until two and then she said "It's time for bed" ^A
^{Am} She told me she worked in the morning and started to laugh; ^D
^{Am} I told her I didn't and crawled off to sleep in the bath. ^{Bm7} ^{E7}

3 ^A And when I awoke I was alone this bird had flown. ^G ^A
^A So I lit a fire, isn't it good Norwegian wood? ^G ^A

Recorded in October 1965 and released on the LP "Rubber Soul" in December 1965.

Ukulele chord diagrams for the following chords:

- A**: 1st fret, 2nd string; 2nd fret, 4th string.
- G**: 3rd fret, 2nd string; 3rd fret, 4th string.
- Am**: 2nd fret, 2nd string; 2nd fret, 4th string.
- D**: 2nd fret, 1st string; 3rd fret, 2nd string; 4th fret, 3rd string; 5th fret, 4th string.
- Bm7**: 1st fret, 2nd string; 2nd fret, 3rd string; 3rd fret, 4th string.
- E7**: 1st fret, 1st string; 2nd fret, 2nd string; 3rd fret, 3rd string; 4th fret, 4th string.

Strumming pattern: 3/4 SP8. Down, Down, Up, Down, Up.
