

Scales 4: Intervals

n interval is simply the distancebetween two notes. It's quite **A** common in music to talk about intervals - e.g. thirds, fourths, etc - and it's all based on the scale. In the chart I've dealt with most intervals in the scales, but some are easier to discover than others (e.g. the major 7th is fairly rare). I've tried to give some example tunes for the more common ones.
