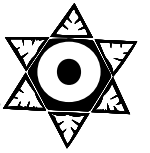


# The Klezmer Collection



## Ose Shalom (traditional)

- C**: Fret 1, strings 2, 3.
- D**: Fret 1, strings 2, 3, 4.
- D7**: Fret 1, strings 2, 3, 4, 5.
- Em**: Fret 2, strings 2, 3.
- E7**: Fret 2, strings 2, 3, 4.
- F#7**: Fret 1, strings 2, 3, 4, 5.
- G**: Fret 1, strings 2, 3, 4.
- Am**: Fret 1, strings 2, 3, 4.
