



Session Advice

- You can't know every tune. It's okay to just sit and listen every so often.
- Sometimes Nigel asks people if they have a request, or a favourite tune; have one ready, even if it's one in the book!
- If you want to suggest a tune for us to play, don't just start playing it. Say "How about Jingle Bells?" or something like that.
- The best sessions are inclusive, not elitist. They're about playing music with other people. However, it's nice to hear someone play a solo now and again. If you'd like to play a solo tune, speak to Nigel and he'll accommodate you.


