According to legend, the illegitimate son of King Gododdin was born in Culross, Fife and looked after by St Serf. He was named Kentigern, but is probably better known by his nickname St Mungo ("dear friend"). He became a missionary and built a church beside the Molendinar Burn in what became Glasgow, and is the patron saint of that city.
