## The Great Scottish Composers

**No.15: Ronnie Cooper** Shetland musician Ronnie Cooper (1934-1982) was a pianist and accordionist from Lerwick. He played in a few bands in Shetland, including the famous Hamefarers, but it is as a composer of tunes that he is most remembered now. His compositions have, in my opinion, an indefinable quality which set them apart from the ordinary. Cooper's best known tunes include The Anvil, Miss Susan Cooper, Ronas Voe, Da Tushkar, Peter Davidson and Hayfield House.
