

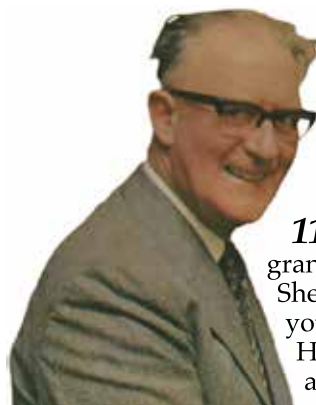

11. Tom Anderson (1910-1991) was taught to play fiddle by his grandfather in Eshaness, Shetland, and went on to collect as much of Shetland's traditional music as he could. He also performed, taught many young Shetlanders (including Catriona MacDonald, Aly Bain and Trevor Hunter). A prolific composer, many of Anderson's tunes are played around the world, his most famous being *Da Slockit Light*.
