## The Scott Skinner Collection

**The Spey in Spate** (J S Skinner)





- 1 Bar A1: Straight D arpeggio pattern. The D arpeggio consists of the notes **D**, **F**# and g, and these are all the notes in the first bar: **D F#D A,DF#A**.
- A little scale run, then a single accidental, then another D arpeggio (A, F#, **D**).
- The chord changes so we have an E minor arpeggio. It consists of the notes e, g and b, and these are all the notes in the third bar: **E GE B,EGB**.
- The whole bar is an A7 arpeggio. 7th chords have 4 notes, as do their arpeggios. The A7 arpeggio consists of the notes **A**, **C**#, **E** and **G**, and these are all the notes in the fourth bar: **ĞĔC#A GEC#A**,.
- 5 Straight repeat of Bar 1.
- 6 This time the scale run is on every second note, with open Ds in between the notes.
- 7 A simple descending zig zag

- pattern in thirds.
- 8 The zig zag pattern continues until a very brief resoltion on the **D**. Immediately we climb up towards the **D** note in the B part.
- 1 D arpeggio pattern: **D F**#**D** AĎF#A.
- 2 Another D arpeggio pattern.
- 3 Again the chord changes so we have an E minor arpeggio.
- 4 Most of the bar can be seen as an A arpeggio: C#EAC# ĚĞ(F#)Ě.
- 5 Straight repeat of B1.
- 6 Straight repeat of B2.
- 7 Straight repeat of A7.
- 8 The zig zag pattern continues until a longer resoltion on the **D**.
