

*American Patrol* (F W Meacham, 1885)

Composed by Frank White Meacham in 1885 for the piano, but it became popular as an arrangement for wind bands as early as 1891. One of its most recognisable performances is the 1942 swing setting recording by the Glenn Miller Orchestra.
