

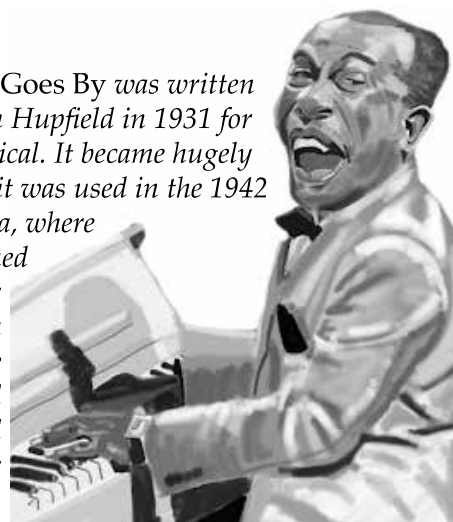


*As Time Goes By* (Herman Hupfeld, 1931)
