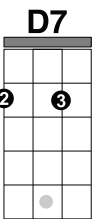
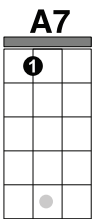
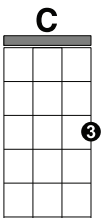
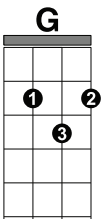
**Ch** Jingle bells, jingle bells, Jingle all the way!
