 leave your key, if I had known for just one second you'd be back to bother me,

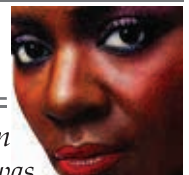
3 Go on now, go, walk out the door, just turn around now 'cause you're not
