

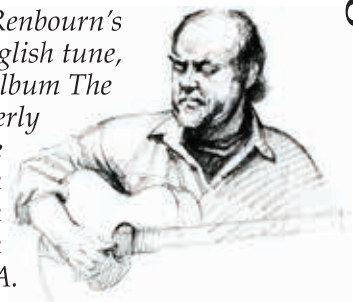

English Dance (traditional 13th Century)
